***Little Hands, Big HeART Children's Exhibition and 2011 Outreach Exhibition***

HAVERFORD, PA (February 15, 2011) — In March, Main Line Art Center will host two inspiring and creative exhibitions featuring work by Art Center students and partners. Both are free and open to the public.

As the saying goes, great things come in small packages...and the littlest artists at Main Line Art Center are no exception. The Little Hands, Big HeART Children's Exhibition will feature the imaginative work of children and teens enrolled in our winter programs. This winter, we offered 43 classes for ages 2-18 in painting, drawing, metals and jewelry, photography, fashion design and illustration, printmaking, ceramics, cartooning, and fiber arts. The exhibition will run March 4-17 and will open with a reception on First Friday, March 4 from 6-9 pm. Come get inspired by the creative and colorful spirits of students in our children's programs at this playful exhibition.

The 2011 Outreach Exhibition: Rhythm and Movement, running March 25-April 9, will feature the vibrant and inspirational work created by participants in the Art Center's Outreach Programs as they use a variety of media to explore rhythm and movement in the world around us. Main Line Art Center is proud to be one of the leading visual arts organizations in the region to make art accessible to diverse groups in our community. The exhibition, which opens with a reception on Friday, March 25 from 5-8 pm, features the work of participants in the Art Center's programs with the County Center for the Blind and Visually Impaired, Elwyn Education Division and Presbyterian Children's Village as well as the Art Center's own Exceptional Art Classes for children and teens with special needs. Main Line Art Center's Outreach Programs are an important part of the Art Center's mission to make art accessible to all ages, levels and abilities.
