## REQUIREMENTS

Artists should submit 4-6 slides or quality digital color jpegs (300 dpi) representing their craft. Publicity visuals are chosen based on the quality of submitted images. Submissions must be representative of actual work to be displayed at sale. Committee reserves the right to refuse display in show, without refund, if work is not as submitted.

Each image must be titled with artist initials, media, price & size (HxWxD), e.g., AM \$68 12" x 2" x 7" porcelain. This would be the document or slide name, not something that is included in the actual image.

Be sure to include a self-addressed, stamped envelope (SASE) with correct postage for return of slides. CDs will not be returned. Copies of images will be retained of all accepted artists.

All work must be handmade in any fine craft media such as ceramics, jewelry, glass, wood, fabric or other one-of-a-kind craft. Historically, the majority of the work sold has ranged in price from \$25 to \$200, although other priced pieces are welcome. No kits, commercially produced items or country crafts will be considered.

## FEES

Application fees have been lowered and are non-refundable. Member fees are \$30, non-member fees are \$35. The application fee goes towards costs of jurying, publicity and printing. Fees MUST be included with application.

## INSTALLATION

Artists must price, set-up and pack their own work and are responsible for their own packing materials. Committee members will check in items with the artist at their scheduled time. Artists MUST be ready with work in logical order. They should set up work after check in. Individual display areas are approximately 3' x 5' depending upon craft. MLAC may provide tables & linens. It is suggested that artists bring their own shelving, tables and limited props if available.

## ARTIST RESPONSIBILITIES

Artists do not need to stay with their work for the entire sale. However, six hours of gallery sitting or a \$90 fee per artist to the Art Center is required. The fee may be pro-rated at \$15 per hour. Accepted artists will be sent a schedule of hours from which to choose. Hours are given out on a first come/first served basis. Artists are asked to gallery sit for security and customer assistance.

## SALES & LIABILITY

Main Line Art Center handles all sales and wrapping. The Art Center retains a 35% commission on all sales and takes all precautions to ensure that items are carefully handled and watched; however, we cannot assume responsibility for theft or breakage. It is recommended that any jewelry or small items be displayed in a locked case. MLAC does not provide locked cases.
