

Important Information Regarding Scholarships

About Scholarships

The Art Center offers scholarship opportunities to families, that demonstrate a financial need and an interest in the arts. While other factors are taken into consideration, scholarships are strictly assigned on the basis of financial need.

Deadline

The deadline for submitting an application for Summer Camp is **June 1 for Sessions A - E and July 6 for Sessions F - J**. Applications submitted beyond the deadline date will not be considered. If all application materials are not received on time the scholarship cannot be granted, without exception. Space in class may not be held while application is in process. Funds are limited and will be dispersed based on financial need.

Eligibility

- Scholarships are for one session per child. Multiple session selections will not be granted. You can apply for scholarship for multiple children. A separate scholarship form must be submitted for each child.

- If your child is already enrolled in a session during summer camp, you may not submit a scholarship for any additional sessions.

- You may not apply for scholarship more than two semesters with in one fiscal year.

Applying for Scholarship*

To be considered for a scholarship all fields of the enclosed application must be completed and returned to the Art Center along with the following materials: a recent tax form or pay stub, a registration form, a personal letter and a letter of support. ***Please Note:** Applications will be returned and/ or postponed, if any of the above items are missing or incomplete.

Processing Procedures

Scholarships will be collected until the deadline date, after which all scholarships will be veiwed collectively.

Payment Procedures

Scholarships cover tuition only. Recipients are responsible for any supplies or fees associated with camp, such as Before Camp Option, Lunch Option and After Camp Option. If receiving a scholarship, any balance must be paid at the time of registration. **Registration must be finalized within 5 days of notice, failure to do so will result in loss of scholarship and space in class will not be held.**

Registration Policies

Scholarships (and scholarship applications) can not be transferable from one session to another.

Scholarships can not be transferable from one child to another another child.
