### The following items will be supplied by the Art Center:

- Clean steam iron, extension cord, water, ironing board
- Clean work surface and chair for each student
- Glue gun, glue sticks
- Assorted fabric pieces in different colors

### Supplies participants should bring to class:

- Notebook and pen
- ½ yard of fabric (for backing your project)
- ½ yard of cotton batting
- Sewing supplies
  - Straight pins (recommend glass head pins)
  - Sharp Fabric scissors
  - Ruler or measuring tape
  - Thread for hand-sewing (Colors you LOVE!)
  - Decorative thread... in different colors/weights (optional)
  - Hand-sewing needles
  - Large eye embroidery needle (sharp point)
  - Assorted fabric pieces/fabric scraps for ruching and applique (cotton, silk, organza, suede, wool, mesh netting)
  - Fray Check or Fabric glue

### Suggested items... Bring some or all of these:

- Buttons, beads, charms, scraps of ribbon and/or lace
- Cotton embroidery floss (Colors you LOVE!)
- Wool or cotton yarn... in different colors/weights
- Petals from silk flowers
- Other found objects and 'treasures'

### Supplies available in class for purchase from instructor:

- Steam-a-Seam-2 Lite
- Embroidery Floss in assorted colors
