Scholarship Application

ABOUT SCHOLARSHIPS

The Art Center offers scholarship opportunities to families that demonstrate a financial need and an interest in the arts. Full and partial scholarships are available. While other factors may be taken into consideration, scholarship amounts are determined on the basis of financial need.

ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships are limited to one week per child during the summer. Multiple-week scholarships cannot be granted. A separate form must be submitted for each child applicant. Children receiving scholarships must be members of the Art Center, either as a child member or under a household membership.

DEADLINE

The deadline for submitting a scholarship application for Summer Art Camp 2017 is May 15, 2017. Applications received after this deadline will be considered on a first-come. first-serve basis until all funds are dispersed.

APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

To be considered for a scholarship, all fields of the application form below must be completed and returned to the Art Center along with all of the required items: a registration form (from the Summer Camp brochure), copies of recent tax forms or pay stubs for all contributing adults, a personal letter of intent and a letter of support by May 15th. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Submitting a scholarship application does not guarantee a space in the summer camp program and spaces will not be held during the application process. Funds are limited and will be dispersed based on financial need.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT POLICIES

Scholarships cover tuition only. Scholarship applications will be collected up until the deadline, and then will be considered collectively.

Any remaining balance due must be paid within one week of receiving notice of scholarship award. Failure to do so will result in loss of the scholarship award.

Scholarship money and/or scholarship applications may not be transferred from one session to another, or from one child to another without authorization by the Registrar.
